Departs: Daily 1 Jan-31 Oct 2026

**Day 1: Amman-Petra-Amman**

Pick up from either hotel in Amman or Amman airport. Proceed on modern Desert Highway, which marches through Jordan's breathtaking flat and sandy core in a speedy three and a half hours to Petra. Petra, dating to around 300B.C. was the capital of the Nabatean Kingdom. Accessible via a narrow canyon called Al Siq, it contains ancient tombs and temples carved into pink sandstone cliffs, earning its fitting nickname, the "Rose City." Petra is the city in which Indiana Jones hunted for the Holy Grail in the blockbuster movie Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade. On arrival visit the archaeological site which enchants visitors from all corners of the globe. Take a short horse ride or walk to the entrance of The Siq and marvel at the remarkable colour of the rocks while walking through it. See the stunning Treasury with its towering façade and explore a myriad of other architectural wonders including rock cut tombs, temples, funerary halls and rock reliefs. After the exciting visit you will be driven back to Amman and dropped off at your hotel.

**Day 2: Petra**

Enjoy a tour of the ancient city of Petra created by the Nabatean people, an industrious Arab people, who settled in Jordan more than 2000 years ago. The site is accessed by walking through a kilometre long chasm (siq), the walls of which soar 200 metres high. At the end of the siq the famous Treasury dramatically appears. Embark upon various walks and climbs to discover hundreds of buildings, tombs, baths, funerary halls, temples and colonnaded streets. View the haunting rock drawings, a 3000 seat open air amphitheatre. Dinner and overnight in Petra. (B, D)



**Day 3: Petra-Amman**

After breakfast transfer to Amman Airport for your departure. (B)

Day 1: Amman

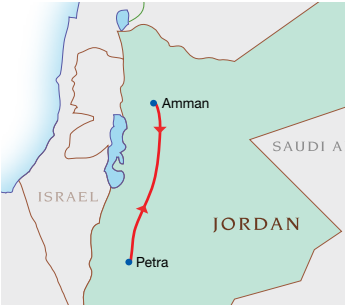
Arrive at Amman Airport and transfer to your hotel in Amman for overnight.

Day 2: Amman-Petra-Amman

In the morning departure from your hotel and drive via the desert way to Petra, Jordan's national treasure and the best known tourist attraction. Although most of what can be seen at Petra today was built 2000 years ago, the area is known to have been inhabited from as early as 7000 to 6500 BC. See the magnificent Treasury, Petra's most famous monument used in the final sequence of the film Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade. Also see a 3000 seat theatre from the early 1st century AD, and various other temple facades, rock carved tombs, funerary halls and houses. Afternoon departure back to Amman for overnight. (B)

Day 1: Amman-Madaba-Mt Nebo-Dead Sea-Petra

Upon arrival, meet and greet your private driver before departing to Madaba for a tour of St. George's Church, home of the famous mosaic map of the Holy Land. Continue on to Mount Nebo to see the memorial of Moses before proceeding down to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth, for a chance to swim. Then continue onto Petra to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (D)

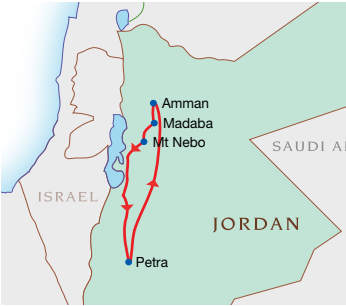
Day 2: Petra

After breakfast visit ancient city of Petra, the legacy of the Nabataean's, an industrious Arab people settled in Jordan more than 2000 years ago. Accessed through a kilometre long walk through a narrow rock gorge, known as the Siq, Petra's most famed and renowned façade of the Treasury is a dramatic sight. Wander and explore through this site with literally hundreds of structures scattered throughout the site including tombs, baths, funerary halls, temples, arched gateways, colonnaded streets – as well as a 3000 seat open air amphitheatre. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

Day 3: Petra-Amman

After breakfast, depart the hotel and transfer back to Amman to the airport for departure. (B)

Note: This tour can operate in reverse if clients arrive late on day 1 but depart with late flight on day 3.

**Departs:** Daily 1 Jan-31 Oct 2026

### Day 1: Amman-Petra

On arrival you will be met at Amman airport or Allenby Bridge and transferred to your hotel in Petra via Desert Highway for dinner and overnight. (D)

### Day 2: Petra-Dead Sea

Today visit Petra. Often described as the eighth wonder of the ancient world, it is a vast, unique city carved in to sheer rock face. Take a short horse ride through the siq and emerge at the stunning Treasury. Explore the ancient city and see a magnificent theatre, and various tombs, temples, baths and colonnaded streets. After a break for lunch depart the amazing city of Petra and continue to the Dead Sea, a salt lake whose banks are more than 400m below sea level, the lowest point on earth. Its famously hypersaline water makes floating easy, and its mineral-rich black mud is used for therapeutic and cosmetic treatments at the local resorts. Relax in the gently lapping waters where you can't sink, or try the well-known healing powers of minerals from the sea's muddy floor. Dinner and overnight at your Dead Sea hotel. (B, D)

### Day 3: Dead Sea-Mt Nebo-Madaba-Amman

Depart from the Dead Sea to Mount Nebo to visit the memorial of Moses, the place where Moses climbed to survey the Promised Land. Continue to Madaba, the city of mosaics best known for its spectacular Byzantine and Umayyad mosaics, it is also home to the famous 6th century mosaic map of Jerusalem and other holy sites. Drive to Amman with its breathtaking amphitheatre and colonnaded street and take a panoramic tour of the city to see the Souks of Amman, the mosque of King Abdullah the first, and the modern city of Amman with its remarkable architecture. Dinner and overnight in Amman. (B, D)

### Day 4: Amman

Departure transfer from your hotel to the airport. (B)

**Departs:** Daily 1 Jan-31 Oct 2026

### Day 1: Amman

Meet and greet by a representative at Queen Alia airport and transfer to your hotel in Amman.

### Day 2: Amman-Petra

After breakfast drive to Petra. Visit the 'Red Rose' city that is now a UNESCO World Heritage site. Walk through a kilometre long chasm, to see the stunning and dramatic Treasury. Various walks and climbs reveal literally hundreds of buildings, tombs, baths, funerary halls, temples and haunting rock drawings. You can also admire the site's 3000 seat open air amphitheatre, awe-inspiring in design and brilliant in creativity. You'll be amazed at the sheer size of this creation which was completely cut out of rock (B, D)

### Day 3: Petra-Madaba-Mount Nebo-Dead Sea

After breakfast, we drive to Madaba the 'City of Mosaics', which is home to the famous 6th century mosaic map of Jerusalem. Continue to Mount Nebo, the presumed site of Moses' death and burial place. Then drive to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth, lying approximately 400 metres below sea level. It is believed to be the site of five biblical cities, and is also renowned for its curative minerals. Dinner and overnight at your hotel near the Dead Sea. (B, D)

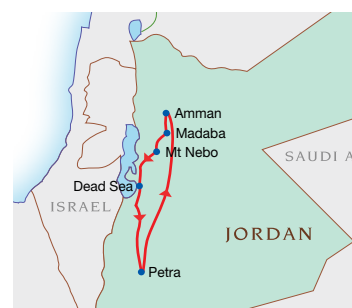
### Day 4: Dead Sea-Amman

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and drive to Amman. Tour the city's ancient citadel taking in sights such as the Temple of Hercules, the Umayyad Palace and the Byzantine Church. At the foot of the Citadel lies a 6000 seat Roman theatre dating back to 151AD. Dinner and overnight in Amman. (B, D)

### Day 5: Amman

After breakfast, transfer to Amman airport. (B)

# Jordan Express

**Departs:** Daily 1 Jan-31 Oct 2026

**Day 1: Amman**

On arrival transfer to hotel for dinner and overnight in Amman.

**Day 2: Amman-Jerash-Amman**

After breakfast visit the city of Jerash, sometimes misleadingly referred to as the “Pompeii of the Middle East or Asia”, due to its size, extent of excavation and level of preservation. Jerash is considered one of the most important and best preserved Roman cities in the Near East. It was a city of the Decapolis. Take a fascinating tour of this unique ancient Greco-Roman city, and walk the colonnaded streets taking in sights such as Hadrian’s Triumphal Arch, Hippodrome, Forum, and Amphitheatre. Return to Amman for a tour of city including visit to Citadel, Amphitheatre and Souk. Free afternoon in Amman to explore the city. (B, L)

**Day 3: Amman-Madaba-Mt Nebo-Petra**

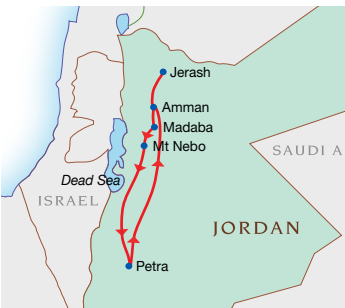
Morning depart Amman and drive to Madaba and visit St. George’s Church, home to the mosaic map of the Holy Land. On to Mt Nebo approximately 817 metres above sea level, mentioned in the Bible as the place where Moses was granted a view of the Promised Land that he would never enter. Lunch on the way. Drive to Petra for dinner and overnight. Optional visit to Dead Sea. (B, L)

**Day 4: Petra-Amman**

Early morning visit to Petra. View the magnificent Treasury, temples, tombs, houses and the amphitheatre. Lunch served at a restaurant inside the Petra site. Afternoon drive back to Amman. (B, L)

**Day 5: Amman**

After breakfast transfer to the airport. (B)



**Departs:** Daily 1 Jan-31 Oct 2026

**Day 1: Amman**

Upon arrival at Amman Airport, meet and greet with our representative and be transferred to your hotel.

**Day 2: Amman-Jerash-Mt Nebo-Madaba-Petra**

After breakfast depart for the magnificent and sometimes ignored ancient Roman provincial town of Jerash. Referred to as a Rome away from Rome, Jerash is commonly considered to be the best preserved Roman city in the Near East. Explore temples, arches, theatres and the Forum. Continue onto Mount Nebo, the most revered and holy site in Jordan due to being location in which Moses first saw the Promised Land. Next stop is Madaba which has become famous for its fantastic mosaics including that of the Holy Land. Finally, arrive at your hotel in Petra for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

**Day 3: Petra**

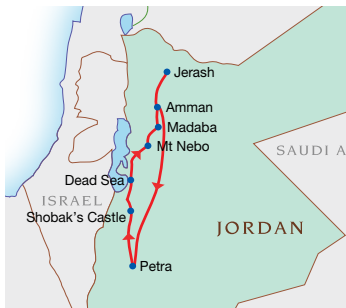
Enjoy a full day devoted to the Red Rose City. Beginning with a horse ride through the Siq, watch as the famed façade of the Treasury appears before your eyes. Explore the site’s tombs, temples, baths, funerary halls and the 3000 seat open air amphitheatre. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

**Day 4: Petra-Shobak’s Castle-Amman**

Drive north via Crusader Castle, known as Shobak. Hovering on the edge of a mountain-side, it was built in 1115 by the King of Jerusalem to protect the road from Egypt to Damascus and later fell to the power of Saladin. After arrival in Amman, enjoy an afternoon city tour of the Citadel and Amphitheatre interspersed with modern architecture. Overnight in Amman. (B, D)

**Day 5: Amman**

After breakfast, transfer to the airport. (B)

This morning tour the Decapolis city of Jerash (founded in 300 BC) to experience a unique ancient Roman city. Visit Hadrian's Triumphal Arch, the Hippodrome, and the Forum, and stroll through the impressive colonnaded streets, to see the churches and Amphitheatres. Return to Amman for a short orientation tour visit Amphitheatre, Souk and the Citadel. Overnight Amman. (B, L)

### Day 3: Amman-Madaba-Mt Nebo-Kerak Castle-Petra

# Marvels of Jordan

**Departs:** Daily 1 Jan-31 Oct 2026

**Day 1: Amman**

On arrival transfer to hotel for dinner and overnight in Amman. (D)

**Day 2: Amman-Um Qais-Jerash-Amman**

After breakfast, visit Um Qais - a ruined Decapolis city with magnificent views of the Sea of Galilee and according to the Bible, the spot where Jesus cast out the Devil from two mad men into a herd of pigs. Continue to Jerash for lunch. Jerash is the site of the ruins of the Greco-Roman city of Gerasa, also referred to as Antioch on the Golden River. Take a tour of this unique ancient Greco-Roman city, meander through the colonnaded streets taking in sights such as Hadrian's Triumphal Arch, Hippodrome, Forum, and Amphitheatre. The Hippodrome once seated 15,000 spectators for chariot races and other sports and is thought to have been built in mid 2nd or 3rd Century AD. Return to Amman for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

**Day 3: Amman-Desert Castles-Amman**

This morning visit the Desert Castles - number of minor castles and fortresses scattered over the desert in eastern Jordan. See Kharaneh (The Caravanserai), Baths of Amra, and Al Azraq (the Roman defense fortress). Return to Amman for a sightseeing tour of the city. Amman is the capital and largest city of Jordan. It is the country's political, cultural and commercial centre and one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in the world. The tour will visit the Citadel and the Amphitheatre, then continue with a panoramic tour of the Souks of Amman and the Mosque of King Abdullah the first. Overnight in Amman. (B, L, D)

**Day 4: Amman-Madaba-Mt Nebo-Dead Sea-Kerak-Petra**

Morning tour of St. George's Church in Madaba, home to the mosaic map of the Holy Land. The Madaba Map is the oldest extant map of the Holy Land and is dated to the middle of the 6th century AD. It was discovered late in the 19th century, during an excavation and reconstruction of a mosaic floor in St George's Church in Madaba, Jordan. After journey to Mt Nebo, traditionally believed to have been the place where Moses saw the promised land. Proceed to the Dead Sea for lunch and swimming to soak out any ailments, then tour the famous Crusader Castle in Kerak. Drive to Petra for overnight. (B, L, D)

**Day 5: Petra-Wadi Rum**

Full day in Petra. View the magnificent Treasury, temples, tombs, houses and the amphitheatre. Lunch served at a restaurant inside the Petra site. In the evening leave Petra for Wadi Rum, also known as The Valley of the Moon, a unique valley of coloured sand dunes surrounded by beautiful rugged mountains. Wadi Rum has been inhabited by many human cultures since prehistoric times, with many cultures—including the Nabateans – leaving their mark in the form of rock paintings, graffiti, and temples. Overnight at Wadi Rum. (B, L, D)

**Day 6: Wadi Rum-Aqaba**

After breakfast, take a four wheel drive tour of Wadi Rum - the largest and most magnificent of Jordan's desert landscape. Lunch under Bedouin tents. Continue to Aqaba for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

**Day 7: Aqaba-Amman**

Morning free in Aqaba to enjoy the beautiful sandy beaches and the Red Sea. After lunch depart to Amman via the spectacular Wadi Araba. Dinner and overnight in Amman. (B, L, D)

Day 2: Amman-Jerash-Amman

Visit the ancient ruins of the provincial town of Jerash and explore one of the best preserved Greco-Roman towns outside of Europe. Feel the history come alive in the original Roman Hippodrome. After lunch head back to Amman, the capital and largest city of Jordan, for a panoramic tour of the city. Day 3: Amman-Desert Castles-Amman

Today involves a trip into the desert to see the famous Desert castles. Visit three of the best including Qasr Kharana, an interesting example of early Islamic Architecture; Qasr Amra, the best-known of the desert castles located in present-day eastern Jordan built in the 8th Century BC; and Qasr Azraq, the 'Blue Fortress' built by Romans under the rule of Diocletian and is a large fortress in the area. Drive to Amman for overnight. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Amman-Madaba-Mt Nebo-Kerak-Petra

Drive to Madaba, the city of mosaics and see the amazing 6th century mosaic map of Jerusalem found in the local church. Continue to Mt Nebo, mentioned in the

Bible as the place where Moses was granted a view of the Promised Land that he would never enter. The view from the summit provides a panorama of the Holyland and to the north. Short stop at Kerak Castle, a dark maze of stone-vaulted halls and endless passageways. Continue to Petra for overnight. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Petra

After breakfast depart for a fascinating tour of the ancient and magical city of Petra, an Arabian historical and archaeological city that is famous for its rock-cut architecture and water conduit system. Experience the awe as you turn the corner to see the Treasury, one of the most recognisable façade's in the world. See the immense façades and structures of the Temple of the Winged Lions, and amphitheatre. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Petra-Wadi Rum

Morning free in Petra. Later in the afternoon drive to Wadi Rum for a unique 4 wheel drive through the amazing desert landscape. Also known as The Valley of the Moon, Wadi Rum is a valley cut into the sandstone and granite rock in southern Jordan 60 km to the east of Aqaba; it is the largest wadi in Jordan. Spend the night in traditional camp in a tent just outside the national park. Enjoy your night gazing at the stars and watching traditional Bedouin performance around the campfire. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Wadi Rum-Dead Sea

Depart Wadi Rum after breakfast for the Dead Sea. Rest of the day at leisure to relax in the gently lapping waters and be amazed that you can't sink and try the well known healing powers of the minerals found on the sea's muddy floor. Enjoy your dinner gazing at the spectacular sunset. (B)

Day 8: Dead Sea-Amman

After breakfast, transfer to Amman airport. (B)

**Day 2: Amman-Desert Castles-Amman**

After breakfast, visit the ruins of Amman's Roman theatre, the citadel, the Umayyad Palace and the Archaeological and Folklore museums. Around its colonnaded main street, see the Cardo, South Theatre, Temple of Zeus, Hadrian's Arch, the Artemis Temple and the Nymphaeum. The city's 14 churches date from Byzantine time and are filled with fine mosaics. Continue westward to Saladin's 12th century Arab castle, Qalaat al Rabad (Ajloun), one of the finest examples of military architecture. Return to Amman hotel for overnight. (B, D)

## Day 4: Amman-Madaba-Mt. Nebo-Kerak-Petra

After breakfast, proceed to visit Madaba; The city of finest collections of Byzantine mosaics, many fine examples of which are well preserved, Several church floor mosaics can be seen in their original locations, Madaba's real masterpiece, in the Orthodox Church of Saint George, is the 6th century AD mosaic map of Jerusalem

and the Holy Land – the earliest religious map of the Holy Land in any form to survive from antiquity, then visit Mt. Nebo; the place where Moses gazed at the Promised Land before he died and believed to be his burial place. You visit the old monastery; overlook the Jordan Valley, Dead Sea, Jericho and Jerusalem, drive to visit Kerak Castle; one of the most important Crusader Castles in the region, drive to hotel in Petra, dinner and overnight. (B, D)

## Day 5: Petra-Petra Visit-Petra

Today visit the red rose city Petra, the biggest attraction of Jordan. Petra was first established around the 6th century B.C. by the Nabatean Arabs, a nomadic tribe who settled in the area and founded a commercial empire, you can start the trip on horseback or by foot to the canyon, the so called Siq, and then walk to the most beautiful monument: The Treasury, from here we explore the city to see the Street of Facades, the Royal Tombs and Pharaoh's Castle, transfer to Petra for dinner and overnight. # Jordan General Information

## Introduction

Once an important Roman outpost, Jordan is a country of mesmerising beauty incorporating remote deserts and canyons, as well as the coral reefs of the Red Sea. Experience the scale of Petra called the Red Rose City and marvel at the architecture of the buildings set deep inside a narrow desert ravine. Experience the lowest point on earth as you float on the unsinkable Dead Sea and explore Wadi Rum, the country's largest desert landscape.

## Visas

A Visa is required for entry into Jordan. Travellers booking with us a package of 2 or more nights can obtain a free visa. Alternatively Visa can be obtained from the Jordanian Embassy or at Amman's airport on arrival. Approx. cost is AUD\$60 per person for a single visit. Those arriving from Israel by Allenby Bridge must obtain their visa prior as it is not available on this bridge.

## Population

The population was estimated to be at just over 9.5 million in 2015.

## Time Zone

Jordan is two hours ahead of the Greenwich Mean Time and has daylight saving from the last week in March to the last week of September. During Australian Summer, Jordan is approximately nine hours behind AEST and during Australian Winter, approximately seven hours behind.

## Electricity

200Ac volts, 50hz, same as in Australia. Two pronged or three pronged European Style cylindrical plugs are used.

## Climate

Jordan has a hot, dry climate characterized by long, hot, dry summers and short, cool winters.

## Amman Airport General Information

- Queen Alia International Airport (airport code AMM) is located 35 kilometres from downtown Amman. New upgraded airport building is operating from June 2013 including 2 terminals located only approximately 150 metres from each other.
- It takes approximately 35 minutes to reach airport from Downtown Amman.
- Transfer from Airport to Dead Sea hotel takes approximately 45 minutes.
- Transfer from Airport to Petra takes approximately 3 hours.
- Transfer from Airport to Aqaba takes approximately 4 hours.

## Official Language

Arabic is the official language; however English is widely spoken, particularly in the cities and around major tourist attractions.

## Food

Like some other Middle Eastern countries, there are many characteristics shared. However, the inclusion of yoghurts and cheeses separate Jordan from the rest. Most restaurants in main cities have menus with both Arabic and European dishes with specialties including Meze, a selection of starters including fool, a type of stew, hummus, moutabel (smoked eggplant dip) and tabouleh. Other dishes include Mensaf, stewed lamb in yoghurt sauce; Makloubat, chicken with spices; Kibbi, deep fried lamb or beef with ground wheat, onion and cinnamon; and Baklava, honey-nut filled pastry.

## Currency

The official currency is the Jordanian Dinar and the dinar is divided into 100 Piasters or 1000 Fills. Most credit cards are accepted but smaller shops still prefer cash payments. ATMs are available. Euros and USD can easily be exchanged.

## Getting There

**By Air:** Most major airlines such as Emirates, Etihad, Qatar and Singapore Airline have flights from Australia. Amman can also be reached from most European cities.

**By Sea:** The only Jordanian connection to the sea is at Aqaba. There are regular ferries from Nuweiba and Taba in Egypt to Aqaba.

**By Land:** Jordan can be reached via 3 bridge crossings from Israel; the Sheikh Hussein Crossing in the north, The Allenby Bridge (King Hussein), near the Dead Sea & the Wadi Araba Crossing in the South.



## Getting Around

As Jordan is a relatively small country any major destination can be reached in approx. 5 hours driving time as the road network is good. Car rental is not recommended. A 4-wheel drive is needed to drive off road and in the desert area, especially Wadi Rum.

**Ramadan:** During the month of Ramadan, Muslims abstain from eating and drinking during daytime, tourists travelling during this time are generally not affected except some historical sights close at approx. 3pm.

**Weekends:** As Friday is the public holiday for Muslims, most businesses and shops are closed on that day, weekends are considered to be Friday and Saturday.

## Things To Do

**Amman:** The capital city is mainly known as the home of the Roman Theatre, still in operation, and the Citadel with its intriguing archaeological museum.

**Petra:** The Rose Red City, see the vast, unique and fascinating city built by the Nabataean Arabs, which is actually carved into the rock face of unique and spectacular rose colour. See its treasury, funerary and the extraordinary Theatre. For those fit enough, don't forget The Monastery perched high above the valley up 900 steps.

**Jerash:** Jerash is one of the best preserved Roman Provincial Towns, second only to Petra in tourist appeal. It was hidden under centuries of sand until being slowly excavated and restored over the past 70 years. Gaze and admire the original Hippodrome, colonnaded streets, the temples, theatres and the spectacular squares and plazas.

**Wadi Rum:** A classic picture of sandy desert with sandstone hills rising sheer out of the valley floor, towering over a small Bedouin village. The best way to discover 4000 year old rock drawings and unearth other treasures hidden within the wilderness is by 4WD with a local Bedouin driver.

**Other Destinations:** Aqaba, in the south, for its white sandy beaches and beautiful coral reefs, Dead Sea where one cannot sink and home to beauty products. ## VALIDITY:

## HOW TO BOOK:

Contact your Travel Agent or Greece and Mediterranean Travel Centre Pty Ltd to make your reservations.

A booking request is accepted when we issue a written booking confirmation. It is at this point that a contract between us and you comes into existence subject to these Booking Conditions. We reserve the right to decline any booking at our discretion. No employee of ours other than a director has the authority to vary or omit any of these Booking Conditions or to promise any discount, refund or credit.

Confirmed bookings will be issued with an invoice upon confirmation detailing all services booked. It is your responsibility to ensure all details are correct. The right is reserved to correct any errors in rates quoted or calculated for any service notwithstanding that the invoice may have been paid in full.

## SERVICES

The services we provide to you are limited to (a) the arrangement and coordination of your travel arrangements; and (b) the delivery of travel arrangements which we directly control. ## PRICES & EXCLUSIONS

We will not be responsible for any other loss or loss you incur in connection with your booking (for example, airfares and visa expenses) if you are prevented from commencing or continuing your trip in these circumstances.

## CANCELLATIONS OR RESCHEDULING BY US

In these Booking Conditions, the term Force Majeure means an event or events beyond our control and which we could not have reasonably prevented, and includes but is not limited to: (a) natural disasters (including not limited to flooding, fire, earthquake, landslide, volcanic eruption), adverse weather conditions (including hurricane or cyclone), high or low water levels; (b) war, armed conflict, industrial dispute, civil strife, terrorist activity or the threat of such acts; epidemic, pandemic; (d) any new or change in law, order, decree, rule or regulation of any government authority (including travel advisories and restrictions).

### Force Majeure – Prior to travel

If in our reasonable opinion we (either directly or through our employees, contractors, suppliers or agents) consider that your travel arrangements cannot safely or lawfully proceed due to a Force Majeure Event then we at our discretion may elect to:

- reschedule your travel arrangements (in whole or in part); and/or
- cancel your travel arrangements (in whole or in part), in which case our contract with you will terminate (in whole or in part).

If we cancel any of your travel arrangements, neither of us will have any claim for damages against the other for the cancelled arrangements. However, we will refund payments attributable to the cancelled travel arrangements less: (a) unrecoverable third party costs and other expenses incurred by us for the cancelled travel arrangements; (b) overhead charges incurred by us relative to the price of the cancelled travel arrangements; and (c) fair compensation for work undertaken by us in relation to the cancelled travel arrangements until the time of cancellation and in connection with the processing of any refund.

### Force Majeure – During travel

To the fullest extent permitted by law, we will not be responsible for any omissions or modifications to the itinerary or the inclusions due to Force Majeure or other circumstances beyond our control happening after we have accepted your booking. This includes any loss of enjoyment or distress caused by omissions or modifications.

If you are entitled to any compensation for any modifications or omissions, then you agree it will be reduced by the value of any alternative services we provide which you accept.

We will not be responsible to you for any other expenses or loss you incur resulting from any amendment or change to the itinerary or its inclusions.

## UNUSED & DENIED SERVICES
